## SAFFETY AND UPKEEP TIP



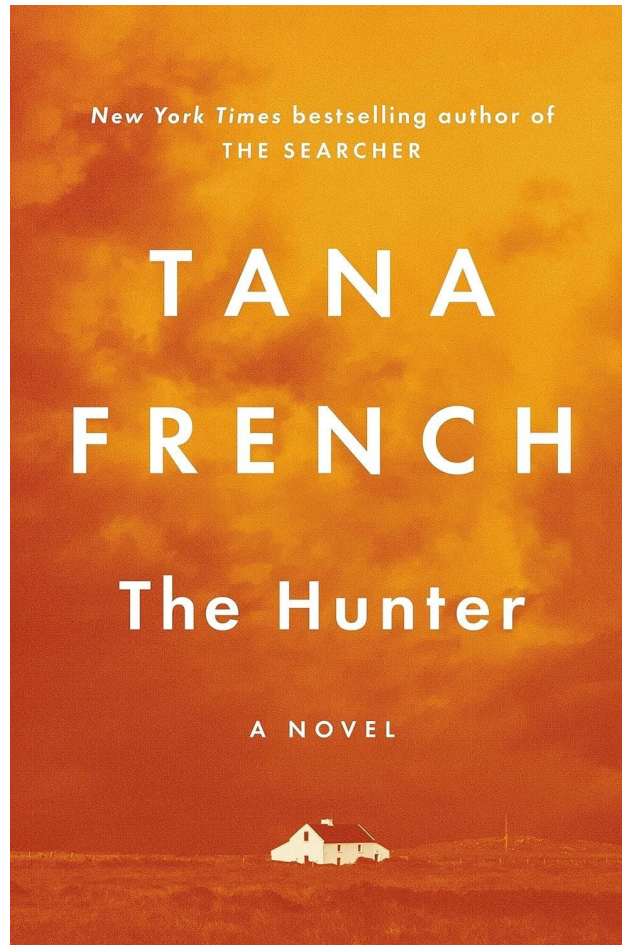
